Wireless Interactive announces completion of Orion-900, 900 MHz OFDM wireless deployment in Iraq

Laguna Hills, CA—(Business Wire)August 1, 2006—Wireless Interactive Comm., Inc. announced today the completion of its newest network in Iraq utilizing the *Orion-900*, 900 MHz radios as a network of wireless backbone infrastructure which then is redistributed using the *RedFire-200*, 2.4 GHz WIFI product line.

“Satellite is Iraq’s only source for incoming and outgoing internet traffic, linking the country to the rest of the World. However, this traffic must be redistributed using other means. Given the lack of wired infrastructure, wireless is the only option,” states Mr. Mohammed Omed Ali, CEO of Impulse for Communication and IT. “We have had tremendous success in the past with the *RedFire* product line. Due to WIFI congestion, it has been difficult to get to hard-to-reach places. The *Orion-900* has filled this void. It allows us to extend our customer reach twice that of the *RedFire*, to remote locations. We then utilize the *RedFire* to provide WIFI coverage to the public. What is special about the *Orion-900* is that each installation does not have to stop there. The same unit can act as a repeater in order to extend our network reach even further in the future.”

The *Orion-900* product line was specifically designed for point to multipoint, backhaul applications. Traditionally, backhaul applications were point to point only due to bandwidth restrictions. The high power (up to 1W) *Orion-900* can transmit up to 22 Mbps of effective throughput compared to 1-3 Mbps the competition has to offer. In addition, it is one of the world’s first OFDM radios within the 900 MHz spectrum. It is a cost-efficient way to extend large amounts of data into remote locations, while then redistributing that data via some other less expensive method such as WIFI.
